

About our Conductor



Cory Pederson has been the principal conductor of the Columbia River Symphony for the last 15 years. The husband/wife team of Angela Pederson-Calvin and Cory Pederson co-founded the symphony in 2007 and shared conducting duties for the first two years.

Currently, Cory is in his 18th year in

the Jewell School District, located in the Coast Range east of Seaside on Hwy 103. He has taught general music to Kindergarten through 4th grade for 15 years, and concert band for 5th -12th grades for 16 years. His high school ensembles have received multiple awards in the Oregon State Band competitions. Cory has worked with multiple schools and community ensembles for over 16 years. He is now in his third year as the Superintendent for the Jewell School District. Currently Cory conducts three ensembles outside of his main job. For the past eleven years, Cory has been the conductor of the Little Ballet Theater Orchestra which performs live music for the Astoria Nutcracker Ballet performance each year in Astoria Oregon. He is also the conductor for the North Oregon Coast Symphony (11th year) based in Seaside, Oregon titled, the North Oregon Coast Symphony.

As a trumpet player, Cory has also performed with the Vancouver Symphony and the IWASH (Idaho-Washington) Symphony. Locally, he has performed with the North Coast Big Band, North Oregon Coast Symphonic Band, Astoria Chamber Players and the North Oregon Coast Symphony.
